

Statement on Interim Rule for Section 889(a)(1)(A) of the National Defense Authorization Act

As many of our customers are aware, the U.S. Department of Defense recently issued an interim rule to implement Section 889(a)(1)(A) of the National Defense Authorization Act for FY2019 (NDAA). The NDAA was passed by Congress in the summer of 2018. Section 889(a)(1)(A) includes language that prohibits federal agencies from purchasing certain Chinese-produced telecommunications and video surveillance products and services. The recently issued interim rule implements that purchasing prohibition, which takes effect August 13, 2019. We are disappointed that the U.S. government is moving forward with the purchasing prohibition. The prohibition was hastily enacted without any supporting evidentiary basis or due process. To be clear, the prohibition only relates to federal agencies. Commercial entities may continue to purchase Dahua products, as may state and local governments generally.
